



# Flu vaccines 2020 to 2021 season

# 6 months to under 2 years

In a clinical risk group

**QIVe** (Quadrivalent influenza vaccine, egg-grown)





# 2 years to 11 years

All children with no contraindications to LAIV

**Quadrivalent LAIV** (Live attenuated influenza vaccine, nasal spray suspension)(iii)



# 2 years to less than 9 years

In a clinical risk group and LAIV medically contraindicated

**QIVe** (Quadrivalent influenza vaccine, egg-grown) – for 2 to 3 year olds check 'licensed from' age for appropriate vaccine







# 11 years to 17 years

In a clinical risk group and no contraindications to LAIV

**Ouadrivalent LAIV** Live attenuated influenza vaccine, nasal spray suspension)(iii)



# 9 years to 64 years (iv)

- 9 years to 17 years in a clinical risk group and LAIV contraindicated
- 18 years to 64 years in a clinical risk group
- pregnant women
- frontline health and social care workers

QIVc (Quadrivalent influenza vaccine, cell-grown)

or QIVe (Quadrivalent influenza vaccine, egg-grown) as an alternative to QIVc









## 65 years and over

All 65 years and over (and those who will turn 65 years before 31/03/2021)<sup>(v)(vi)</sup>

**aTIV** (Adjuvanted trivalent influenza vaccine)(v)

or OIVc (Ouadrivalent influenza vaccine, cell-grown) if aTIV not available

65 years of age

(i) Available to order from ImmForm for children 6 months to 2 years

(ii) Subject to additional supply becoming available late autumn

(iii) Some people may not accept the use of porcine gelatine in medical products such as LAIV, for details on alternative vaccine offer available later in the season see PHE information for healthcare practitioners 'The National Childhood flu Immunisation Programme 2020 to 2021' (iv) The aim is to further extend the vaccine programme from November and December to include the 50-64 year old age group subject to vaccine supply. This extension is being phased to allow prioritisation of those in at risk groups first

(v) Although aTIV is not licensed for those less than 65 years of age it is recommended that those who will become 65 years of age before 31 March 2021 can be offered the vaccine 'off label'

(vi) TIV-HD Trivalent influenza vaccine (Sanofi Pasteur) suitable for 65 years of age and over but not eligible for reimbursement under NHS flu vaccine programme.
